Principal's Message:

School Plan for Student Achievement: Currently, administrators, teachers and School Council parents are busy analyzing STAR test scores, CELDT scores for English Language Learners, 5th Grade P.E. state testing results, and numerous classroom assessment data pieces in preparation of revisiting and re-writing our 2012-13 "School Plan for Student Achievement."

Each school's plan is a critical roadmap for the year. It is a plan comprised of specific goals and actions to raise the academic performance of all students to the level of performance goals established under the California Academic Performance Index (API) and the federal No Child Left Behind legislation. Goals are created in various areas such as Math, Language Arts, Writing, English Language Development, Special Education and Physical Education. Each goal has identified "actions" that include tasks that are implemented, measured and reviewed throughout the year to determine progress towards those important goals. In addition, our school's categorical budgets are tied directly to our School Plan's goals. In relation to our SUSD Board's goal of remaining fiscally solvent, our expenditures in the School Plan are carefully identified, allocated and monitored so that each school can successfully attain their goals while remaining fiscally responsible.

We are very excited to announce that we met many of our 2011-12 School Plan goals for our various student sub groups. Congratulations to all the staff, students and parents who worked very hard last year at raising test scores to meet our "Safe Harbor" targets as identified by the state.

During the last several weeks, I have been meeting and planning with teachers, classified staff and our School Site Council parents to respond to our latest testing data to ensure our School Plan promotes the highest of student achievement for all students. New goals and actions were identified for the new 2012-13 School Plan that legally must be approved by Rosedell's School Site Council, Saugus Union School District's Board of Education and California's Department of Education. The plan will be adopted by our School Site Council at next Tuesday's meeting and will be available in the office for all stakeholders to review. Thank you to all the stakeholders who have spent a great deal of time working with me to ensure our School Plan is an effective roadmap towards attaining greater student achievement.

All information is strictly confidential. ALL students are identified by the cafeteria computer with a PIN number (the same ID number they have always used at the school). An application is available from your cafeteria personnel; at the Food Services Agency website www.scvschoolnutrition.org; or at your request, we can mail an application home – just call the Food Services office (1-661-295-1574 ext. 115 or 108).
