Message from Assistant Superintendent of Business; Cynthia Shieh: Passage of Proposition 30 and what it means to Saugus Union School District:

For education, passage of Proposition 30 avoids additional draconian cuts and we can generally expect **flat funding** year over year with some relief on deferrals from previous years. It means the avoidance of an additional three-week reduction in the school year for K-12 districts.
