We are very excited and proud to announce that Wells Fargo accepted our proposal and awarded our school the grant at a special reception in Woodland Hills last Friday!

We greatly appreciate **Wells Fargo, and Mr. Garcia**, for their generosity of giving back to the community to help Rosedell further our technology plan. The grant will be used towards the next set of purchases of Smartboards and projectors for classrooms. This grant furthers Rosedell's three year vision set forth by Site Council, PTA and our teachers to install Smartboards in each classroom to enhance teaching and learning for our students.
