<u>Child & Family Center:</u> The Child & Family Center is hosting a free community seminar on Youth Violence & Aftermath on Thursday, January 17th from 6:30 – 8:00pm at 21545 Centre Pointe Parkway in Santa Clarita. There will be question and answer session – How to talk about traumatic events, trauma response and red flags of serious mental illness.

<u>Parking, Pick up and Drop Off Safety Procedures:</u> We need to be extra vigilante about student safety when parking, picking up, or dropping off students at school. This serves to remind our families of safety procedures before and after school when student traffic congestion is high.

- 1. Our student drop off valet service 7:40-8:10 each morning in front of school is provided for all students to safely exit cars when being dropped off at school in the morning. **Driving through the staff parking lot is prohibited to drop off children**-this causes congestion for our valet cars and is unsafe for students.
- 2. When dropping off / picking up students in the K parking lot in the morning, please park your car in a parking space or in the street to walk your children to and from the gate. This area is reserved for afternoon childcare buses and no cars are permitted to drive through to pick up their children. It is unsafe to have children walking into the lot unattended to get into a car.
- 3. When dropping off in the K parking lot in the morning, **never stop or park your car in the driveway area to leave it unattended** so you can walk your child to the gate. This causes huge traffic issues that extend to the Urbandale/ Rosedell intersection, and affects the flow of traffic from Bouquet Cyn Blvd causing several other families to be late
- 4. Please use crosswalks or corners to cross the street when arriving or leaving school. It is difficult to see around parked cars and trying to cross in the middle of the street is not only unsafe, it is illegal and a poor example to show our students.

Unfortunately we do not have enough staff resources to provide a valet service at the K lot so we expect personal courtesy and respect from all of our families to ensure all of our students are safely arriving and leaving school.

Our best suggestion is to plan ahead to arrive to school before 8:00, when traffic congestion is minimal. Parking in the street before and after school allows you to enjoy a few minutes to walk with your child during the day. Slow down, show respect and courtesy, and make the drop off and pick up times for your children pleasant and safe for everyone.
