Kindergarten & Transitional Kindergarten Round Up Week: February 25th–March 1st is Kindergarten and Transitional Kindergarten Round Up. You can pick up a packet in our office at 7:00am on Monday, February 25th. We will start registration at 8:30am in the MPR. The following information is required to complete registration: Original birth certificate provided by the County Registrar/County Recorder or passport, Verification of immunizations and two proof of residency (utility bills, lease/escrow/rental papers with address.

Age Requirements:

Kindergarten entry – children that turns 5 by October 1st Transitional Kindergarten "TK" – children that turn 5 between October 1st and December 2nd

Parking, Pick up and Drop Off Safety Procedures: We need to be extra vigilante about student safety when parking, picking up, or dropping off students at school. This serves to remind our families of safety procedures before and after school when student traffic congestion is high.

1. Our student drop off valet service 7:40-8:10 each morning in front of school is provided for all students to safely exit cars when being dropped off at school in the morning. **Driving through the staff parking lot is prohibited to drop off children**-this causes congestion for our valet cars and is unsafe for students.

2. When dropping off / picking up students in the K parking lot in the morning, **please park your car in a parking space or in the street to walk your children to and from the gate.** This area is reserved for afternoon childcare buses and **no cars are permitted to drive through to pick up their children.** It is unsafe to have children walking into the lot unattended to get into a car.

3. When dropping off in the K parking lot in the morning, **never stop or park your car in the driveway area to leave it unattended** so you can walk your child to the gate. This causes huge traffic issues that extend to the Urbandale/ Rosedell intersection, and affects the flow of traffic from Bouquet Cyn Blvd causing several other families to be late

4. Please use crosswalks or corners to cross the street when arriving or leaving school. It is difficult to see around parked cars and trying to cross in the middle of the street is not only unsafe, it is illegal and a poor example to show our students.

Unfortunately we do not have enough staff resources to provide a valet service at the K lot so we expect personal courtesy and respect from all of our families to ensure all of our students are safely arriving and leaving school.

Our best suggestion is to plan ahead to arrive to school before 8:00, when traffic congestion is minimal. Parking in the street before and after school allows you to enjoy a few minutes to walk with your child during the day. Slow down, show respect and courtesy, and make the drop off and pick up times for your children pleasant and safe for everyone.

Kindergarten School Age Program Registration: The Child Development Programs Incoming Kindergarten School Age Program registration will be held as a lottery. Please see the Child Development Site Supervisor during the week of **February 25th – March 1**st to complete a *Kindergarten Interest Form*. The lottery will be held on Tuesday, March 5th. You will then be contacted if your lottery form was drawn. All remaining families will be placed on a waitlist based on their drawing number in the lottery. If you have any questions, please contact the site supervisor, Heather Gonzales at 661-294-5336.

Preschool Registration: Rosedell preschool offers a multi-day option. Priority will be given to families with a child who will be four years old on or before October 1st, of the current school year, who live within Rosedell boundaries and who desire the 5-day preschool program. A 3-day (Monday/Wednesday/Friday) and a 2-day (Tuesday/Thursday) program are also an option based on space availability. In addition, if space permits, children who reach three years of age by September 2nd of the current school year, and are toilet trained, may also be enrolled in the 2-day option.

Please see the Child Development Program Site Supervisor during the week of **February 25th** –**March** 1st, 2013 to complete a *Preschool Interest Form*. Two utility bills and an official birth certificate are required to complete a *Preschool Interest* Form. The lottery will be held on Thursday, March 7th. You will then be contacted if your lottery form was drawn. All remaining families will be placed on a waitlist based on their drawing number in the lottery. Full-Day Preschool Located Bouquet: The Child Development Programs is offering a year-round, fullday and multi-day (2, 3, or 5-day), preschool program (6:30am-6:00pm) at the Bouquet campus. Children who are 4 on or before October 1^{st} of the current school year and 3 on or before September 2^{nd} of the current school year; toilet trained, and reside within SUSD boundaries are eligible. Children residing outside of SUSD boundaries will be eligible to enroll, space permitting.

State Preschool: A half-day state preschool program is available at the Cedarcreek and Rio Vista Child Development centers to income eligibile children who will be 4 on or before October 1st of the current school year. If space permits, children who are 3 on or before October 1st of the current school year will be enrolled.
