#### **Principal's Message:**

<u>Celebrating President's Day and America!</u> Since we are fast approaching President's Day weekend, it is once again time for Americans to reflect and celebrate our amazing Presidents who have shaped our nation! Soon our second graders will be visiting the Mayor at City Hall to learn first hand about the importance and role of local government. Our Student Council and Classroom Representatives are engaging and learning our democratic principles with every Student Council meeting held with Mr. Kuabasak! Who knows? Maybe we have a future Mayor, Congressman, Senator or President at Rosedell Elementary.

Accelerated Reader Program: Parents, if you haven't already heard, we have a wonderful reading program here at Rosedell called Accelerated Reader (AR). This program is available to all grade levels through our school computers. After a student reads an AR book they can take a quiz and immediately receive feedback on how well they comprehended what they read. Rosedell, in hopes of encouraging even more participation, has set a goal for our site which is to read one billion words. Students will have individual goals based on their grade level. Students who meet their individual goal will be recognized with a certificate at the end of the year. The words that a student reads by the end of each year, will then roll over with them to following year. For example if a 2nd grade student reads 3,000 words by the end of this year, when they start 3rd grade they will already have 3,000 words to use to their new 3rd grade goal. Listed below are the goals for each grade level. Please continue to encourage your child to read every night so that Rosedell can reach their goal!

The Benefits of Regular Student Attendance and Impact Budget: Another way to help keep our schools fiscally solvent is to ensure your student's attendance is regular! Schools receive less state funds when <u>each</u> student does not show up to school on a <u>daily basis</u>. The state monitors each school's daily attendance and our Saugus schools have lost a considerable amount of money from students who have irregular days off from our calendar, due to many reasons (extended vacations, trips to Disneyland or visiting their out-of –town relatives etc. Schools are paid roughly \$35 per student per day. Overall, our district loses several hundred thousand a year due to student absences. Remember to keep ill students home. However, if they're feeling much better (24hrs after a fever without medication etc.), please send them to school. Thanks!

<u>Congratulations</u>: Congratulations to three Rosedell teachers for writing grants to help fund technology and the arts in their classroom. **Mrs. Standley** and **Mrs. Walker** received grant funding from Santa Clarita Valley Education Foundation for additional technology in their classrooms, such as iPods for student use, and two classroom laptops to use for Smartboard teaching. **Mr. McGroary** received a Target grant to fund his 6th grade classroom trip to the Getty Museum. We are very proud of our teachers for seeking additional funding sources to supplement their classroom curriculum!

<u>Kindergarten & Transitional Kindergarten Round Up Week:</u> February 25<sup>th</sup>–March 1<sup>st</sup> is Kindergarten and Transitional Kindergarten Round Up. You can pick up a packet in our office at 7:00am on Monday, February 25<sup>th</sup>. We will start registration at 8:30am in the MPR. The following information is required to complete registration: Original birth certificate provided by the County Registrar/County Recorder or passport, Verification of immunizations and two proof of residency (utility bills, lease/escrow/rental papers with address.

#### Age Requirements:

Kindergarten entry – children that turns 5 by October 1<sup>st</sup> Transitional Kindergarten "TK" – children that turn 5 between October 1<sup>st</sup> and December 2<sup>nd</sup> **Open Enrollment:** February 1<sup>st</sup>–28<sup>th</sup> is open enrollment. If you are interested in transferring to another school in our district or to Emblem Academy, please come in to our office for transfer forms. For the 2013-14 school year, Rosedell will be open for transfers.

**Kindergarten School Age Program Registration:** The Child Development Programs Incoming Kindergarten School Age Program registration will be held as a lottery. Please see the Child Development Site Supervisor during the week of **February 25<sup>th</sup> – March 1<sup>st</sup>** to complete a *Kindergarten Interest Form*. The lottery will be held on Tuesday, March 5<sup>th</sup>. You will then be contacted if your lottery form was drawn. All remaining families will be placed on a waitlist based on their drawing number in the lottery. If you have any questions, please contact the site supervisor, Heather Gonzales at 661-294-5336.

**Preschool Registration:** Rosedell preschool offers a multi-day option. Priority will be given to families with a child who will be four years old on or before October 1<sup>st</sup>, of the current school year, who live within Rosedell boundaries and who desire the 5-day preschool program. A 3-day (Monday/Wednesday/Friday) and a 2-day (Tuesday/Thursday) program are also an option based on space availability. In addition, if space permits, children who reach three years of age by September 2<sup>nd</sup> of the current school year, and are toilet trained, may also be enrolled in the 2-day option.

Please see the Child Development Program Site Supervisor during the week of **February 25<sup>th</sup> –March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013** to complete a *Preschool Interest Form*. Two utility bills and an official birth certificate are required to complete a *Preschool Interest* Form. The lottery will be held on Thursday, March 7<sup>th</sup>. You will then be contacted if your lottery form was drawn. All remaining families will be placed on a waitlist based on their drawing number in the lottery. <u>Full-Day Preschool Located Bouquet:</u> The Child Development Programs is offering a year-round, full-day and multi-day (2, 3, or 5-day), preschool program (6:30am-6:00pm) at the Bouquet campus. Children who are 4 on or before October 1<sup>st</sup> of the current school year and 3 on or before September 2<sup>nd</sup> of the current school year; toilet trained, and reside within SUSD boundaries are eligible. Children residing outside of SUSD boundaries will be eligible to enroll, space permitting.

**State Preschool:** A half-day state preschool program is available at the Cedarcreek and Rio Vista Child Development centers to income eligibile children who will be 4 on or before October 1<sup>st</sup> of the current school year. If space permits, children who are 3 on or before October 1<sup>st</sup> of the current school year will be enrolled.
