Karen Haas: I have taught for 32 years. The grades I have taught range from a 2-3 split to a 5-6 split and all the grades in-between. My whole career has been at Rosedell. I never even considered transferring because the school and community have been so wonderful! I truly think of Rosedell as my second family, and I will miss everyone immensely.

Chris Hankla: I have been a teacher for 35 years: 33 years at Rosedell and 2 years at a private school in Playa del Rey. I have taught kindergarten exclusively, except for the one year I taught a K/1split. One year I did not have a teaching partner, so I taught a K class in the morning and an extended day K class in the afternoon as part of intervention.

I feel very much connected to the Rosedell community. I delight in reconnecting with families whose children I have taught previously. It has been a privilege to watch students grow and change into adulthood. I am thrilled to have former students come back for visits. I may not recognize them at first glance however, because they remain forever 5 years old in my heart and memory. Parents of students are far easier to recognize and it is always a pleasure when I can catch up with families in the aisles of the grocery store.

Karen McCallon: I started my teaching career at the high school I graduated from as a Home Economics teacher. I later moved to California and got my degree in Elementary Education after volunteering in my children's classes and later as an aide. I have been at Rosedell for 14 years, taught private school for five years, and substituted in Saugus District for 5 years while my children were little. Deciding to retire has been a long process, but I am looking forward to spending more time with my family and traveling. I have developed many friendships with Rosedell families over the years and look forward to further developing those. Rosedell will always hold a very special place in my heart because of the many children that I have had the privilege of teaching and the many people I have worked with over the years.
