Fall Registration: The Saugus Union School District is going paperless for parents to update their children's enrollment information and to be notified of their 2013-2014 teacher. The entire process will be handled online through our student information database. What this means for you:

- A website address with access codes and instructions will be sent home with your child's final report card.
- Between July $15^{\text {th }}$ and August $2^{\text {nd }}$ you may go to that site to update all of the information that you used to complete on hard copies the first week of each new school year.
- The parent student handbook with all of your parent rights and responsibilities will available on the website when you register.
- Once registered, you will be able to enter changes and updates at any time throughout the year by visiting the website.
- On August $12^{\text {th }}$ after 5 p.m. you will be able to $\log$ in and see whose class your child has been assigned to for the 2013-14 school year. Class lists will no longer be posted at the school.
