Principal's Message:

<u>SCV Final Mile Challenge - This Sunday, November 3rd:</u> Parents, if your child completed his/her Mileage Logs and is participating in the Final Mile Challenge, please note the updated information below:

- Teachers will return student's completed Mileage Logs so parents can view event information on the last page.
- All participants meet at the Pavillions' parking lot no later than 12:30pm to stretch and prepare for the run to the Westfield Valencia Town Center Mall. Pavillions on McBean and Magic Mtn. Parkway (near the Elephant Bar).
- Parents should drop off students at Pavillion's and drive to Westfield Town Center to cheer on and pick up students as they finish. The finish line is very busy, so it is important to be there as students finish running.
- Students run after the official marathon ends, so they will not be in contact with adult runners.
- Strollers are forbidden. Parents and younger siblings are discouraged from running. **Parents** with a Kindergartener may walk/run along side his/her child.
- Administrators and teachers will be at the start and finish lines to supervise students. City officials will also be helping in the organization of each school group. There will be three schools this year each with different colored shirts. This year we chose the color orange.
- The student's T-shirts have arrived and will be given to students before the end of Wednesday.

We hope to have a great amount of Rosedell student participation again this year so we can be invited back for next year! Students will have a great time participating in this fantastic city event!

Front of School: Thank you all for being patient as I work towards developing plans for beautifying the front of the school. The last few months, I've been working with the district and outside companies on developing a cost efficient plan to upgrade and redesign the front of the school. Please note we are accessing limited district capital improvement funds that are tied to facility projects. We are in the process of determining the redesign that deals with the sickly trees and their destructive root systems (destroyed our water pipes last year and continues to threaten underground systems), defective sprinkler system, and overall lack of greenery and plants. The current plan calls for a beautifully paved intersecting walkway through a large grass area, new larger rosebushes in the planters and new deciduous trees that are less destructive and allow grass to grow at the front of the school. We look forward to completing this project in the next few months. The current proposal and drawing is available in the office if you would like to see it!
